The City of Toronto is building affordable housing at 150 Queens Wharf Road, which has been part of the City’s vision for the community since master planning began more than 25 years ago.

The City and CreateTO are updating the proposal that was last presented to the public in 2016. The updated proposal will include a combination of affordable rental units and market rental units.

Join us online or by phone on Monday, March 8<sup>th</sup> for a Community Meeting to learn more about this affordable housing project and the preliminary development concept for the site.

This development is part of the City of Toronto’s Housing Now Initiative and the HousingTO 2020-2030 Action Plan. The City’s target is to approve 40,000 affordable rental and supportive homes by 2030.
