The responsibilities of the Financial Analyst include preparing proforma financial analysis and reports, performing asset and market due diligence, preparing ad hoc financial models and analysis, liaising with internal and external groups to gather supporting details and information, and improving the quality and efficiency of financial reports and models. **This position is for a 1 year (12 months) contract with an opportunity for it to become a full-time permanent position.**
